By laying some small restrictions on Bridge Office Results, you have a piece of luck of getting a high input speed and unequalled user friendliness.

6 Pairs per group	28 Pairs per group
1 Round	19 Rounds
1 Board per round	9 Boards per round

You have only to choose the scheme that a group plays and you can start.

No input of names and/or numbers before you can put in the scores.

Names are optional and can be add later with one click with the mouse.

You can adjust the number of groups, pairs, rounds and boards per round.

You can distribute the movement sheets or use table cards and you can after the boards starts, put in the results.

With Bridge Office Results more then 360 schemes are delivered.

From all around 360 schemes you can print movement sheets.

From more than 100 schemes you can print table cards.



Registration

Registration is obligatory.

Bridge Office Results asks these data only once.

You received a serial number with the CD.

If you have bought Bridge Office Results from Bridge Office, this number is on the invoice.

If you have bought Bridge Office Results from one of our dealers, this number is on the CD or at the inside of the box.

If you want to change the name of the club or install an update, you have always need this serial number.

Change with "Name club" the name of your club.

Change with "Location club" the name of the location of your club.

Click the button "Register".

Bridge Office Results now uses your club name.

When download updates from Bridge Office Results, only the serial number is left behind on our website.

Manner of game

You can document the way of playing as a standard setting.

If you have the same number of groups every play evening, put in that number here.

You can also raise or reduce the number of groups with the little arrows at the right side of the input field.

Groups

Put in here the number of groups, which Bridge Office Results always starts with.

Rounds

Put in here the number of rounds, which Bridge Office Results always starts with.

Boards

Put in here the number of boards per round, which Bridge Office Results always starts with.

You can always change these settings.

Click the button "Save" to document these standard settings.



Input

Input per board

If you prefer import per board, you put in the results after all rounds are played.

You can put in the results in two different ways.

Scores or biddings.

Mostly the input of biddings is used to check if the input of the scores leads to the same result.

There can be a slip of the pen which can not be recognized as such by Bridge Office Results.

Input per round

If you prefer per round, you put in the scores after each round.

You can put in the results in two different ways.

The scores or the biddings

Mostly the input of biddings is used to check if the input of the scores leads to the same result.

There can be a slip of the pen which can not be recognized as such by Bridge Office Results.

The import you use belongs to the standard settings.

When you click the button "Save", Bridge Office Results starts with these settings each time.

You can always change these settings.



Clock

Here you can make adjustments to use Bridge Office Results as a clock.

Round time

Here you put in the time that a round may take without moving.
Usually this is 7 minutes per board.

Warning

Here you indicate when a signal is given before the end of the round time by Bridge Office Results.

Usually is this 5 minutes.

Movement time

Here you indicate how many minutes you need to move.
Bridge Office Results gives a signal as soon as the round time is over.
After the movement time the clock starts on the round time again.
Movement time is usually 2 minutes.

The clock belongs to the standard settings.

If you click the button "Save" Bridge Office Results starts these settings.

You can always change these settings.



Competitions

You can make two different competitions.

Normal competition

In an normal competition you can add the result to a competition.

You can calculate an average ranking or a weighed average ranking.

Personal competition

In this competition you also can add the result to a competition.

The pair names are split up and the scored percentage will be given to both players.

In this competition you can drop lowest scores and highest scores as many times as you want.

You can always change this.



Normal competition

With a competition you can add rankings to let calculate an average over the played matches.

You can add as many rankings you want, but if added more results to a competition as fits on a paper sheet, Bridge Office Results will not print this competition.

If you want to compose this competition or a personal competition, we advise you to use always the names and groups files you made with Bridge Office Results.

So you avoid critical errors with the names.

Bridge Office Results looks to the names of the players.



Start a competition

Choose a date under Results.

Click on the group of which you want to compose a competition.

Click the button "Put in as many as possible"

Bridge Office Results asks you if you want to start a new competition.

Click the button "Yes"

The results will be removed from the upper list to the lowest list and Bridge Office Results has filled up number 1 with "Competition Number".

We advise you to leave the numbering to Bridge Office Results to avoid that you overwrite another competitions.

Now click the button "Save".



Add results to an existing competition

Choose the date you want to add to a existing competition.

Click on the group you want to add to a competition.

Click the button "Put in as many as possible".

If all names from the upper list are placed, click the button "Save".



Add unregistered pairs

It can happen that some pairs were absent or played in another combination as at the start of the competition.

Because of this the pairs stay in the upper list of the result.

To add these pairs yet, you click on the concerning pair.

The pair you clicked on is now in the window with the score they obtained.

You still can change both data.

If the pair must be added as they played, nothing changes.

Click the button "OK" and Bridge Office Results asks you if the concerning pair must be added to the competition.

Then click the button "Yes" and the pair is added to the competition.

If you have to add more pairs who did not take part in a competition yet, add them in the same way.

Bridge Office Results automatically gives substituted scores.

You can always change them.

Click the button "Save" to save the competition.



Make a ranking with weighted averages

Now you can calculate a weighted average in a competition.

There only looked at if a different number of boards played over more sessions in a competition, by for instance a sit-out pair.

NOT weighted: $45\% + 66\% + 50\% \div 3 \text{ Sessions} = 53.67\%$

Weighted: $(45\% \times 24) + (66\% \times 20) + (50\% \times 24) \div (24 + 20 + 24) = 52,94\%$
24, 20, 24 are the numbers of boards played.

If a pair plays with a reserve player we try to use the weighted average if one of both pairs or both pairs can be found through the name.

For instance:

Usual the pairs play: Ms. M. Ashford - Mr. B. Ackart
Mr. R. Everard - Mr. D. Dunlevy

Now the pairs play: Mr. B. Ackart - Mr. R. Everard
Ms. M. Ashford en Mr. D. Dunlevy do not play.

The weighted average will now calculated for both pairs because Mr. Ackartn as well as Mr. D. Everard can be found.

Calculate a result with a weighted average is not obligatory registered and from that not committed by the NBB.

Anyhow the NBB advises you to do this. (NBB is Dutch Bridge Association)



Percentage for not played session

By clicking the button "Not played" you enter a window where you can put in replacing percentage for 10 not played sessions in a competition.

Bridge Office Results will use these percentages and completing them automatically, with this next rule.

Has a pair at the moment of absence an average score that is higher than the percentage filled in at "First time not played" the pair receives the percentage filled in at "First time not played".

The next absence they get the score that is filled in at "Second time not played".

Has a pair at the moment of absence an average percentage lower as filled in at "First time not played" this pair receives the percentage they scored till now.

This score will be adjusted after every played session.
You can adjust the score manual.
This will not be a replacing score but an adjusted score.



Remove a pair from the competition

If you want to remove a pair from the competition, click on the concerning pair in the lower list.

If Bridge Office Results asks you if you want to remove the selected pair, click "Yes". The selected pair is removed from the competition.

Click the button "Save".



Change the pair's name ore percentage

Click in the lower list on the field where you want to change the percentage.
A window appears in which you can change the name of the pair and the percentage.

If you tick "Do not show as adapted score", the place where the score placed back, stays white.

If you don't tick "Do not show as adapted score", the place where the score placed back will be light blue.

Here you can recognize if it is a replaced score.
Replaced scores can be used when for instance two players from different groups play together.
Than click the button "OK".



Replace all results of a played date

Choose first the play date you want to change in the frame "Results".

Choose the group of which you want to change the play date.

Choose the competition left side below.

Click the button "Put in as many as possible".

Bridge Office Results asks you if you want to replace the date concerning.

If you want to replace the entire date, click "Yes".

Then click the button "Save".



Remove date from a competition

If you want to remove an entire date from a competition, click on the concerning field with the date in the lowest list.

Bridge Office Results asks you if you want to remove the chosen date.
If you click "Yes", the date will be removed from the list.

Then click the button "Save", and the chosen date is removed permanently.

If you do NOT click the button "Save" but for instance the button "Back", the date will not be removed.



Have a look at a competition

In the frame "Groups" you see "Group A", Group B" etc.

Here you can see that there is minimal 1 competition for group(s) shown in the frame.

If you want to see "Group A", tick "Group A".

If you want to see "Group B", tick "Group B".

Choose under "Competitions" that competition you want look into.

Click the button "Print" to print the competition.

Click the button "Make HTML" to make a HTML page of this competition.



Make a HTML file from a competition

You can make a HTML file from a competition.

This HTML file is put in the directory "Internet" under the name "Competition.HTML".

If there is a ranking in the directory "Internet", Bridge Office Results asks you if the competition must be combined to the page with group ranking.

If you choose "Yes", than there will not be made a separate HTML file for this competition, but the file keeps the name "result.html", which includes this competition.

If you use Microsoft Internet Explorer, you can send this HTML file with this Internet Browser with "Send this page".

If some of the recipients can't receive HTML files, paste the HTML file in to the body and send it.



Personal competition

With making a personal competition it is important that you compose the groups with Bridge Office Results and not type them in manual.

So you avoid critical errors with names.

Bridge Office Results looks to the names of the players.

You can add as many rankings you want, but if added more results to a competition as fits on a paper sheet, Bridge Office Results will not print this competition.

You can drop the lowest and highest scores as many as you like.



Start a competition

Select a date under Results.

Click on the group of which you want to compose a competition.

Then click the button "Put in as many as possible".

Bridge Office Results will ask you now if you want to start a new competition.

Click the button "Yes".

The pairs will split up by Bridge Office Results.

If Bridge Office Results meets "Cp.", the couple will split up in "Mrs." and "Mr.".

The results will be removed from the upper list to the lowest list and Bridge Office Results has filled in number 1 to the "Number competition".

We advise you to leave the numbering to Bridge Office Results to avoid that you overwrite another competitions.

Click the button "Save".



Add results to an existing competition

Choose the date you want to add to a existing competition.

Click on the group you want to add to a competition.

Click the button "Put in as many as possible".

If all names from the upper list are placed, click the button "Save".



Add unregistered pairs

It can happen that some pairs were absent or played in another combination as at the start of the competition.

Because of this the pairs stay in the upper list of the result.

To add these pairs yet, you click on the concerning pair.

The pair you clicked on is now in the window with the score they obtained.

You still can change both data.

If the pair must be added as they played, nothing changes.

Click the button "OK" and Bridge Office Results asks you if the concerning pair must be added to the competition.

Then click the button "Yes" and the pair is added to the competition.

Bridge Office Results meets "Cp.", this couple will be split up in "Mrs." and "Mr.".

If you have to add more pairs who did not take part in a competition yet, add them in the same way.

Bridge Office Results automatically gives substituted scores.

You can always change them.

Click the button "Save" to save the competition.



Percentage for not played session

By clicking the button "Not played" you enter a window where you can put in replacing percentage for 10 not played sessions in a competition.

This is not the same window and percentage as for the normal competition. Bridge Office Results will use these percentages and complete them automatically, with this next rule.

Has a pair at the moment of absence an average score that is higher than the percentage filled in at "First time not played" the pair receives the percentage filled in at "First time not played".

The next absence they get the score that is filled in at "Second time not played".

Has a pair at the moment of absence an average percentage lower as filled in at "First time not played" this pair receives the percentage they scored till now.

This score will be adjusted after every played session.
You can adjust the score manual.
This will not be a replacing score but an adjusted score.



Remove a player from the competition

If you want to remove a player from the competition, click on the concerning player in the lowest list.

If Bridge Office Results asks you if you want to remove the selected player, click "Yes". The concerning player will be removed from the competition.

Click the button "Save".



Change the player's name or percentage

Click in the lower list on the field where you want to change the percentage.

A window appears in which you can change the name of the player and the percentage.

If you tick "Do not show as adapted score", the place where the score placed back, stays white.

If you don't tick "Do not show as adapted score", the place where the score placed back will be light blue.

Here you can recognize if it is an replaced score.

Replaced scores can be used when for instance two players from different groups play together.

Then click the button "OK".



Replace all results of a played date

First select the date you want to replace in the frame "Results".
Select the group of which you want to replace the entire play date.
Select the competition under left.
Click the button "Put in as many as possible".

Bridge Office Results asks you if you want to replace the concerning date.
If you want to replace the entire date, click "Yes".

Then click the button "Save".



Remove date from a competition

If you want to remove an entire date from a competition, click in the lowest list on the concerning field with the date.

Bridge Office Results asks you if you want to remove the selected date.
If you click on "Yes", the date will be removed from the list.

Then click the button "Save", the selected date is removed permanently.

If you don't click the button "Save", but for instance the button "Back", the date is not removed.



Have a look at a personal competition

In the frame of "Groups" you see "Group A", "Group B" etc.

Here you can see that there is minimal 1 competition for the groups shown in the frame.

If you want to see "Group A", tick "Group A".

If you want to see "Group B", tick "Group B".

Select under "Competitions" which competition you want to see.

Click the button "Print" to print the competition.

Click the button "Make HTML" to make a HTML page of the competition.



Make a HTML file from a personal competition

You can make a HTML page of the competition.

This HTML file comes in the directory "Internet" with the name "Personal Competition.HTML".

When there is a result of groups in the directory "Internet", Bridge Office Results will ask you if the competition must be combined with the page with group results.

If you choose "Yes", there will not be made a separate HTML file of this competition, but the file keeps the name "result.html", including this competition.

If you use Internet Explorer of Microsoft, you can send this HTML file via this Internet Browser with "Send this page".



Slam competition

With making a slam competition it's important that you compose the groups with Bridge Office Results in stead of putting them in manual.

Bridge Office Results will be looking to the names in a group.
You can add as many playing dates to a slam completion as you like.
You can print the competition and make a HTML page of this.



Start competition

Click the button "New competition".

Give the competition a name. For instance: Season 2008-2009.

Then click the button "OK".

Choose a "Name file" you also used to compose the groups.

Select the play date Bridge Office Results has to check on slams bid and made.

In the upper list the found scores are described with the group, the hand and the pair that bid and made the slam.

If there is a score in the list like 1440, which could be scored by a "Little slam" as well by a "Grand slam", you need to click on this.

Then click the button "Put as many as possible".

After clicking the button "Put as many as possible" the competition will be saved immediately.

You can add as many play dates to a competition as you like.



Remove a play date from a competition.

Beside the list with the number of slams is a list with the play dates which are admitted in the concerning competition.

Click in the list on the play date you want to remove.

Then click the button "Remove date".

Look in the upper list if you have to adjust a score.

If you have to, click on the concerning line.

Then click the button "Delete".

The concerning date will be removed from the competition.



Sort

You can sort a slam competition on "Most Grand slams", "Most little slams" and on the "Total amount slams"

Below the list you can tick the radio button to sort.



Settings for printing results

Change the font type

You can change the type of font or the font size to show and to print the result.

Ask me to print to the printer queue

If you play with more groups, you can print the ranking of the groups to the printer queue.

Bridge Office Results will start printing, when you have calculated the ranking of all the groups and will print as many rankings as possible on one sheet of paper.

To prevent that Bridge Office Results keeps asking you constantly to print to the printer queue, you don't tick this question.

Bridge Office Results will not ask you any more if must print to the printer queue and every ranking printed directly on a separate sheet of paper.

Tick this question, than, as long as you did not have chosen for printing to the printer queue, Bridge Office Results asks you to print the result to the printer queue.

These setting belong to the standard settings.

If you click the button "Save", Bridge Office Results always starts with these settings.

You can always change these settings.



Select another font type

Select another font type from the list.

You see an example at the right side of the list.

Select another font type can have consequences for showing rankings on the screen and for printing.

If you just want a bigger character, than choose from character size 8 until 16.

The character size has consequences for showing the rankings on the screen and for printing.

It is possible that the combination of font type and font size are responsible for not printing the ranking correctly.



Select another font size

If you just want a bigger character, choose from the character size 8 until 16.
The character size has consequences for showing the rankings on the screen or for printing.

Select another font type from the list.

You see an example at the right side of the list.

Selecting another font type or font size can have consequences for showing the rankings on the screen or for printing.

It is possible that the combination of the font type and the font size are responsible for not printing correctly.



Ask me to print to printer queue

If you play with more groups, you can print the ranking of the groups to the printer queue.

Bridge Office Results will start printing, when you have calculated the ranking of all the groups and will print as many rankings as possible on one sheet of paper.

To prevent that Bridge Office Results keeps asking you constantly to print to the printer queue, you don't tick this question.

Bridge Office Results will not ask you any more if must print to the printer queue and every ranking printed directly on a separate sheet of paper.

Tick this question, than, as long as you did not have chosen for printing to the printer queue, Bridge Office Results asks you to print the result to the printer queue.

These setting belong to the standard settings.

If you click the button "Save", Bridge Office Results always starts with these settings.

Match point listing

In this list you can see how many Match points (Mp's) a specific board has brought in. You can print and save this list.

All files will be saved in ASCII format and readable in every word processor and also in Microsoft Excel.

You can also make a HTML file of this.

If there is a ranking of groups in the directory "Internet", Bridge Office Results asks you if the entry verification list must be combined with the group results.

If you choose "Yes", there will be no separate HTML file made for this match points list, but the file keeps the name "result.html", including this match points list.

If you put in the results as well as "Biddings", the button "Entry verification biddings" gets visible and you can also show the entry verification list of the biddings.

You can print and save this list.

Overview per table

With this list you can see the score per set of boards (per table) from each pair that played in this group.

You can print and save this list.

All files will be saved in ASCII format and readable in every word processor and also in Microsoft Excel.

You can make a HTML page of the overview per table.

This comes in the directory "Internet" under the name "Overview per table.HTML".

When there is a result of groups in the directory "Internet", Bridge Office Results will ask you if the result of this overview per table must be combined with the page with group results.

If you choose "Yes", there will not made a separate HTML file for this overview per table, but the file keeps the name "result.html", including this overview per table.

If you use Internet Explorer of Microsoft, you can send this HTML file via this Internet Browser with "Send this page".



Overview per board

Here you see an overview per board played.

Because the overview per board often is too large, no total MP's and percentages are added.

Bridge Office Results will try to print this overview on one sheet.
So it can happen that the overview is printed on more pages.



Overview per pair

Click on the names from a pair in the list.

You can see now what the score of this chosen pair is in comparison with the scores of the opponents.

The score will be described in Mp's and percentages.

You can print this list.

By clicking the button "Print all pairs", the overview of all pairs will be printed in one time.

Bridge Office Results will try to place as many as possible overviews on one page.

This overview does not appear on the screen.

You can make a HTML page of the overview of all pairs.

There will be made a HTML page of all overviews per pair.

If you use the Internet Explorer of Microsoft, you can send this HTML file via Internet Browser with "Send this page".

If you click on the button "Per board" Bridge Office Results will produce an overview per pair per board.

Overview per pair per board

You get here an overview per pair per board.

The pair can see against whom, at which table they played and what there score is.

You can save this pair and save this overview of all pairs to send them per mail.

Like all files these data were saved in ASCII so they can read by every word processor and also with Excel.

You can print this overview per pair.

You can print this overview of all pairs.

You can make a HTML file of all pairs.

If you use the Internet Explorer of Microsoft, you can send this HTML file via this Internet Browser with "Send this page".



Tops and Zeros

In this list the number of REAL tops and REAL zeros will be showed a pair has scored.
If the number of REAL tops are equal with more pairs then there will be looked at the score of the fewest REAL zeros.

You can print and save this list.

All files will be saved in ASCII format and readable with every word processor and also in Microsoft Excel.

You can make a HTML page of tops and zeros.

This comes in the directory "Internet" under the name "Tops and zeros.HTML".

When there is a result of groups in the directory "Internet", Bridge Office Results will ask you if "Tops and zeros" must be combined with the page with group results.

If you choose "Yes", there will be made no separate HTML file for these tops and zeros, but the file keeps the name "result.html", including these tops and zeros.

If you use the Internet Explorer of Microsoft, you can send this HTML file via this Internet Browser with "Send this page".



Highest and lowest

The highest and lowest percentage ever scored in each group will be shown.

If you for instance archived the results for a year, you can show the highest and lowest percentage of each group at the end of the year.

Of course the date this percentage is scored also is shown.

If you use names, than also the names of the pairs are printed.

You can make a HTML page of the highest and lowest percentage.

If you use the Internet Explorer of Microsoft, you can send this HTML file with this Internet Browser with "Send this page".

Change names in results

If names are used with calculating the result, you can still change them here.

Select first a play date.

Select the group.

Click on the pair of which you want to change one or both names.

Change the name in the text field beneath the list.

Click the button "OK" and the changed name will be returned to the list.

The changing even made in the result and the scores you put in.

You have to make a new HTML page.

Is this result picked up in a competition, you have to adjust the competition to re-write the concerning date.

When printing it is calculated with the settings of the font name and font size you have typed in Settings 1.

Tick the field "Without MP's", the result only shown in percentages.



Import results

Results you have exported, after putting in the scores, can be placed on your home computer with this option.

To do this you place a floppy disk or a USB-Stick.

Define on which drive the results are and select them by clicking on the concerning date. Than click the button "Import" and the results put on the right place.

There is deliberate chosen for this simple way by just giving the drive letter.

ATTENTION:

Because a floppy disk or a USB-stick can filled up complete, we advise you to remove the imported files.

When the import is ready, you receive a message.



Export results

Exporting results is meant to take home the scores you put in.
No search for files you have to copy. Bridge Office Results does it for you.

Select the results you want to take home by ticking the date concerning.
Then click the button "Export".
Bridge Office Results copies the selected results to the floppy disk or to the USB-Stick.

There is deliberate chosen for this simple way to indicate the drive character.

Attention:

You can not put an unlimited number of results on a floppy disk or USB-stick.

If the results are exported to the floppy disk or USB-stick, you receive a message.

Change input date

If you want to check the results again it mostly happens a day later.
You start putting in on a date which is not played on.

If you have checked the scores and you are going to print the result or uploading to the Internet, than this happens by the input date.

With this option you can put back the input date to the play date.

You can go back to the first of January of the current year -8 years.

If it is the year 2008 you can go back to 2000, in the year 2009 you can go back to 2001.

The calendar starts with the date of the results to which you want to give another date.
Select a month (if necessary) and a year (if necessary) and click on the play date.

If you click the button "OK" the new date will be took over.

If you do so Bridge Office Results asks you if you want to overwrite the play (existing) date.

If you click "No" here, you can choose another date.

Scheme control

Here you select the schemes ready you want to use in Bridge Office Results.

The left list is empty and Bridge Office Results have no scheme to use.

Selecting schemes you can do with:

The number of pairs:	4 until 28
The number of tables:	3 until 14
The number of rounds:	3 until 25

Select the schemes you want to use by ticking it on.

Then click the button "Put in ABR" and the selected schemes appear in the list on the left side.

When you have to select a scheme for putting in scores, you see the schemes in the list on the left side.

All present groups of that played that date will be selected by Bridge Office Results.

There are results of 3 groups.
The pairs from group A always start with the number 10.
The pairs from group B always start with the number 11.
The pairs from group C always start with the number 12.
Etc..

Click the button "Calculate result".

If there is a sit out in one or more groups the pair number will be removed first.

The final result.
You see that the start numbers (10, 11 and 12) are adjusted to the names of "Group A,
Group B and Group C".

With the pairs, who had a sit out table, you see the actual scored points and what is
added for the sit out table.
You can print this result.
This result will be saved in ASCII format in the directory "Top" under the directory where
Bridge Office Results is.

You can make a HTML page of the multi session result.
This comes in the directory "Internet" under the name "Multi session.HTML".
When there is a result of groups in the directory "Internet", Bridge Office Results will ask
you if the result of this multi session must be combined with the page with group results.
If you choose "Yes", there will be no separate HTML file made for this multi session
event, but the file keeps the name "result.html", including this multi session event.

If you use the Internet Explorer of Microsoft, you can send this HTML file with this
Internet Browser by "Send this page".



Colour setting

You can adjust the foreground colour, the background colour and the colour of the buttons.

If you did this Bridge Office Results always starts in the chosen colours.

If you want to go back to the yellow colour Bridge Office Results always had, click the button "Undo".

You can print movement sheets of all schemes.

If you want to print names on the movement sheets, click first on the group file in the frame "Groups".

Bridge Office Results fills up the number of pairs per group immediately.

If you change the number of pairs while you have chosen a group file, Bridge Office Results will not print names on the movement sheets.

You can adjust the number of boards per round and the number of rounds.

If you like to print the group name on the movement sheet, tick "Group name".

In the list right above you see the schemes you use in Bridge Office Results.

Now select from the list behind "Group name" by pressing the little arrow down.

You will find all schemes which were found for the number of rounds you selected.

To make a quick change in a group file, you can use Notebook.
If you compose a competition, we advise you, to change the names with Bridge Office Results.

All files of groups, names, results as well as competition will be saved in ASCII format.
These files can be opened with every word processor.
You can also open these files in MS Excel and MS Word.



Input of names

Put in first the names of all your members.

Use Mr. or Mrs. or the abbreviation Cp. (stands for couple).

The column "Mark" is meant in case more players have the same name.

Otherwise you let this field empty.

If you want to keep up a personal competition, use the titles Mr., Mrs., Cp..

Cp. stands for couple but will split up in a personal competition in Mr. and Mrs.

Store this name list by clicking the button "Save".

Give the list a name.

You may define the name of the name list.

You can make as many name lists as you want.

As soon as you click on a name in the list, this name will arrive in the text field behind "Name".

Give the group file (Group list) a name and click the button "OK".

Click on the button "Back" to go back to the main screen.

You can print the group by clicking the button "Print".

With the printing you can print a text to one or more group lists.

You also can print group lists on a separate page.

There is deliberate chosen for a simple way of just giving the drive character.

Attention:

You can not place an unlimited number of results on a floppy disk or USB-stick.



Give pairs a random pair number

It often happens that the pairs in a group keep the same pair number. To avoid, that you always get the same opponents, Bridge Office Results can give the pairs a random pair number.

As soon as you click the button "Give random pair numbers", all pairs in the group receive another pair number.

Click the button "Save" and you can start.

You can repeat this as often as you want to.

You can make the allotment of the random pair numbers undone by clicking the button "Undo".

Open a group file in Notepad

After many requests we have assembled this possibility in Bridge Office Results.
We do not like this because type errors could be made which can cause errors in Bridge Office Results.

But we also say "For you and by you". Usage is for your own risk

You can open every group file you made with Notebook.
In Notebook you can change names, add pairs, remove or replace.

Pay attention that the structure of the file keeps in tact, by changing everything in the same way.
If you deviate, it could be followed by error messages.

If you finished adjusting the group file, you close Notebook and save the changing.

If you use groups for a competition, we advise you to use "Compose groups".
This is only to prevent type errors in a name.



Import groups

First choose the drive where you have the group files stored.

Select the group files you want to import.

Then click the button "Import".

If Bridge Office Results is ready with the import, you receive a message.

We have deliberately chosen for this simple way of just giving the drive character.

Now you can use the groups you prepared.

Changing the groups or names stays possible.



Export groups

Select the files you want to export.

Choose the drive where you want to export the groups to.

Click the button "Export".

You receive a message when exporting is ready.

You can export the groups to a floppy disk as well as a USB-stick.

Bridge Office Results remembers where to you exported the last time.

There is deliberate chosen for a simple way of just indicating the drive character..

Attention:

You can not put an unlimited number of results on a floppy disk or USB-stick.

Settings

To prevent that somebody use your e-mail program, that maybe is another that is used by your colleague, we choose another way to send the mail.
For this Bridge Office Results needs some data.

SMTP server:

The SMTP server of "Yahoo" is "smtp.mail.yahoo.com" and from "Tiscali" it is "smtp.tiscali.co.uk" without quotation marks.

You received a letter from your provider what their SMTP server is.

Fill this in here.

Take care of the correct spelling and the points in the name.

If you do not know the name of your SMTP server than go to the link below.

Username:

The username you must type in here is in the letter you received from your provider.

Password:

The password you must type in here is in the letter you received from your provider.

Your name:

Here you can change nothing.

With this name you are registered by Bridge Office Results.

This name will be used as sender when you are sending results.

The receiver can see now where the mail comes from.

Your E-mail address:

There must be a sender known to send the mail.

Put here your own e-mail address in.

Bridge Office Results sends the e-mail to this address and all others via BCC, so no one else can see the other addresses.

Because you also send the mail to your self, you can check what you have send.

Check with starting up if there is a new version:

When you click on this field, every 2 hours and with starting up Bridge Office Results, you can see if there is a new version on Internet.

You will receive a message from Bridge Office Results.

Send a test mail:

When you have filled in all data for sending an e-mail, the button "Sends a test mail" becomes enabled.

By clicking this button, you sent an e-mail to you yourself.

Open your e-mail programme to see if you received the test mail.

As an attachment the icon of Bridge Office Results has been added.

The subject is Bridge Office Results.

The body is the word "test".



E-Mail addresses

Select first the name file you want to use.

Then type in the e-mail group, where you want to add the e-mail addresses.

Of course it is useful if you gave the group that name that you play with.

Click in the left list on the name of the person where you want to send the results to.

Type the e-mail address of the concerning person.

Click the button "Add".

Bridge Office Results checks if this is a correct e-mail address.

You receive a message if this e-mail address is typed wrong.

Make now on the same way all other e-mail addresses. Then click the button "Save".

Bridge Office Results will ask you if you want to save these e-mail addresses in this group.

If you like to save them, than click "Yes". If not, click "No".

Put in a new group and continue as mentioned above till you have done all groups.

If you want to remove an e-mail address from the list, click on that e-mail address and

In the right list you see which HTML files can be send.

The date behind the files does not need to be the play date.

This is the date the HTML files were made.

First we select the group where we want to send the mail to.

Than select the HTML files you want to send to the selected group.

You can send an own text along with the e-mail.

Put in the text you want to send, in the white frame under the list of the HTML files you want to send.

Click the button "Send E-mail".

If the mail is sent, you receive a message from Bridge Office Results.



Latest news

As soon as you click this button, Bridge Office Results shows you when there is put latest news on our website.

Bridge Office Results will ask you if you like to visit the website.

These changes have no consequences for the standard settings.



Use names

It is not necessary to use names to calculate the result.

If you click on this field, a window opens.

Have you more than 1 group file, you have to select the group file you want to use.

This group file will be the current group file where you calculate the results with.

If you click on "Use pair numbers with name", Bridge Office Results takes along the pair number of the concerning pairs for all further operations.

Bridge Office Results sees the pair number as an element of the pair names.

By clicking the button "Use", Bridge Office Results takes over the names.

If you click the button "Don't use", Bridge Office Results will not use names by calculating the result.

You can add the names after calculating the result.

In Notebook you can change names, add pairs, remove or replace.

Keep attention to, that the structure of the file keeps in tact, by changing every thing in the same way. (Pair numbers, points, spaces)

If you deviate, it can come to an error statement in Bridge Office Results.

If you are ready with adjusting the group file, you close Notebook and save the changes.

The changes will immediately be visible in the previous showed list.

If you use names for a competition, we advise you to change the names with Compose Groups.



Add names later

Select first the play date in the frame "Results".

Tick on the field "Use" in the frame "Names".

Select the group file you want to use and click the button "Use".

The selected group file must have the same number of names as the number of pairs that played that date.

If this is not the case, Bridge Office Results will not use the names in the result.

You can add the pair numbers to the pair names by tick on the field "Use pair number with name".

Then click the button "Start" and calculate the result of each group again.

The names are now added to the selected date.



Results

You will find all played matches when you click down on the little grey arrow in the frame "Results".

Click on the wanted date.

By clicking the button "Stop clock", the clock stops.
The clock starts again with the time set, when you click on "Start clock" again.

You close the clock by clicking on the little cross right above.

You made these settings with "Settings 1" in the frame "Clock".
If the set time is not correct than go back to the screen "Settings 1" and change the time in the frame "Clock"
Click the button "Save" and Bridge Office Results will start the clock next time with this new settings.



Number of pairs and sit out pair

Here you type in the number of pairs of each group and how many pairs play in the concerning group.

Bridge Office Results looks for the sit out pair to:

When you use names, the number of the sit out pair is defined by the group file.
The pair number that is missing here is the sit out pair.
So it can be each random pair.

If you use no names, the program will define the last pair number as sit out pair.
You can change this pair number for the sit out pair in every possible pair number.

If you choose for using names afterwards or otherwise, Bridge Office Results will automatic make this adjustment.
As soon as some thing is wrong with the number of pairs, names or sit out pair, Bridge Office Results will report this.

The number of pairs in a group must be minimal 6 and can be maximal 28.



Rounds and boards

With the input per board you can play 28 rounds.

With 16 or more rounds you have to can play less than 9 boards per round.

With the import per round, you can play maximal 9 rounds of 9 boards each.

You made these settings in the screen Settings (1) with "Manner of game".



Play scheme

You have to select a play scheme for each group.

With Bridge Office Results are more than 360 play schemes delivered.

Dependent of the number of pairs for the concerning groups you can select a play scheme.

If a group has 10 pairs, you only see the schemes for 10 pairs.

Select one scheme for each number of pairs only with "Scheme control", than Bridge Office Results fills it up for you immediately. You do not need to select the scheme than.

Do you or Bridge Office Results select a scheme; a little button appears besides the chosen scheme.

If you click on this button, you will see the complete scheme.

You can print this scheme by clicking the button "Print".

Click the button "Show movement sheets" and the movement sheet of pair 1 will be showed.

Input per board

If you prefer to put in the results per board, you do this when all boards are played.

You can put in the results of the boards in 2 ways.

Score or bidding.

The input of biddings is mostly used to check if the input of scores leads to the same result.

There can be made a type or writing error which Bridge Office Results can not recognize as such.

Think about 2 NT+1 = 150 and 3 down not vulnerable is also 150.



Input scores

First select the group you want to work with by clicking on it.
You do not need to wait until you have collected all travellers of a group.
You can change of group when ever you want.

Click on the board number you want to import or type in the number in the white box and press the enter button.

You now see the traveller of the concerning board.
You can type the scores on the score sheets from up to down successively.

With a PLUS score for North-South you just fill in the score.
For instance: 120, 400, 620 etc..
A MINUS score for North-South you put in as follows.
For instance: -120, -400, -620 etc..

If you type a not existing score, like 320, Bridge Office Results will report this and delete the score.

If you type an impossible score because of the vulnerability, Bridge Office Results will report this but touch the score.

As soon as all scores of the traveller are typed in, the button "OK" is activated and gets the focus.

Press "ENTER" again and the board is saved and you can type the next board number in. Bridge Office Results automatic serves the next board number so you only have to press "ENTER".

For a not played board you type in a "n" or a "N".

Director awarded score

If a awarded score is admitted, you fill in this awarded score for North-South first. Bridge Office Results will give the same awarded score to East-West, but you can change this.

An awarded score of 60% for North-South and 40% for East-West is possible.

Switch of hands

If it concerns a switch of hands, you type in the character "d" before the North-South score and immediately (without space) the score of North-South.

For instance: d-200 of d420.

By clicking the button "Delete board", you delete the input of the entire board.

By clicking a column in the list with the Mp's, you can change an already typed in board. If you click the button of an already typed in board or puts a board number in behind "Board", you can change an filled in board.

As soon as you typed all results of a group, the button "Calculate result" will be visible. You can calculate the ranking or continue with put in the scores of another group.



Input scores without a scheme

First select the group you want to with by clicking on it.
You do not need to wait until you have collected all travellers of a group.
You can change of group when ever you want.

Click on the board number you want to import or type in the number in the white box and press the enter button.

Put in the North-South pair number first.
Than put in the East-West pair number.
If you did this for a group of hands, you do not need to do this for the next hand.
Bridge Office Results does this for you.
You play 4 hands per table and you start with putting in hand number 5.
Put in the North-South pair, than the East-West pair and than the North-South score.
You put in the whole score sheet this way.
If you put in hand 5, hand 7 or hand 8, Bridge Office Results puts in the pair numbers for you.

With a PLUS score for North-South you just fill in the score.
For instance: 120, 400, 620 etc..
A MINUS score for North-South you put in as follows.
For instance: -120, -400, -620 etc..

If you type a not existing score, like 320, Bridge Office Results will report this and delete the score.
If you type an impossible score because of the vulnerability, Bridge Office Results will report this but touch the score.
As soon as all scores of the traveller are typed in, the button "OK" is activated and gets the focus.
Press "ENTER" again and the board is saved and you can type the next board number in.
Bridge Office Results automatic serves the next board number so you only have to press "ENTER".

Knack

With the input of scores there is built in a little trick.

You get a traveller with all the same scores.

Let us presume a score of -1090 for North-South.

Of course it is boring when you play with 18 pairs and you have to put in 9 times -1090.

With Bridge Office Results you have to do this just once.

After the first input of -1090 you press the enter key.

The cursor jumps to the next input field.

Press the enter key again and Bridge Office Results fills in the score of -1090 for you.

Repeat pressing the enter key as often as necessary.

If there is a sit out pair, this will be passed over.

By pressing the enter key, the previous score will filled in.

If you won't to delete a score in one input field, press the character "c".

If you like to type the last 0 (zero), press "Ctrl" and "S" at the same time.

Bridge Office Results reports you "Fast input on".

If you did so, Bridge Office Results remembers this for the future.

Press "Ctrl" and "S" again at the same time, Bridge Office Results reports you "Fast input off".

You now have to put in the last 0 (zero) of the score again.

Bridge Office Results remembers this for the next times.

You can do this as often as you want to.

Click in the score sheet on a pair number, and you can change the Mp's provided by Bridge Office Results.



Change Mp's from a pair

By clicking on the pair number on the traveller, a window opens, where you can change the Mp's Bridge Office Results has admitted.

If you do this after calculating the ranking, you have to calculate the ranking again. You can always change the Mp's of a pair.

13.80 are the Mp's the Cp. Channing receives for the boards they did not play, because of the sit out.

Print

If you clicked on the field "Ask me to print to the printer queue" in Settings 1, Bridge Office Results asks you if the result has to be printed tot the printer queue. Presuming you have played in more groups.

If you click "Yes" nothing will happens at the moment.

As soon as you click the button "Print" with the result of the final group, all results will be printed.

Bridge Office Results will try to print as many as possible results on one sheet of paper.

If you click "No", Bridge Office Results will print the result of a group immediately.

If you did not click on the field "Ask me to print to the printer queue" at Settings 1, Bridge Office Results asks nothing and print the result immediately.

First select the group of which you want to start with by clicking on it.
You do not need to wait until you collected all travellers of a group.
You can change the group when ever you want.

Click on the board number you want to put in and put in that number in the white box and press the enter key.

You see now the traveller of that concerning board.
You can put in the biddings on the traveller successively from up to down.
The biddings of North-South in the column North-South.
The biddings of East-West in the column East-West.
Bridge Office Results calculates the score for you.

As soon as all biddings are put in the button "OK" is activated and gets the focus.

As soon as all scores of a group are typed in, the button "Calculate result" becomes visible.

You can calculate the ranking or continue with the input of bidding from another group.

Input per round

If you prefer input per round, you put in the results after each round played.

You can put in the results in two different ways.

The scores or the biddings.

The input of biddings is mostly used to check if the input of scores leads to the same result.

There can be made a input or writing error which Bridge Office Results can not recognize as such.

Think about 2 NT+1 = 150 and 3 down not vulnerable also is 150.



Input scores

Select the group you want to work with first by clicking on it.
You do not need to wait until you collected all travellers of a group.
You can change the group when ever you want.

Click on the round number you want to put in.
Click on the pair number you want to put in.

Now you see the traveller of the concerning round and pairs.
You can put in the results of the traveller successively from up to down.

With a PLUS score of North-South you put in the score normally.
For instance: 120, 400, 620 etc..
A MINUS score for North-South you put in as follows.
For instance: -120, -400, -620 etc..

If you put in a non existing score, like 320, Bridge Office Results will report this and delete the score.
If you put in a score which is not possibly because of the vulnerability, Bridge Office Results will report this, and do nothing.
As soon as all scores put in the button "OK" is activated and gets the focus.
Press the enter key again and the board is saved and you can put in the next board number.
Bridge Office Results automatically gives the next board number.

After 2 rounds you can calculate an interim score.

Input by table order

If you tick on this box, the pair numbers appears in order of the table numbers.
If you tick off this box, the pair numbers will appear in order of the North-South pair number.
You can change when ever you want.

Not played

For a not played board you put in a "n" or a "N".

Director awarded score

Is an awarded score admitted, you first put in the awarded North-South score.
Bridge Office Results will admit the same awarded score to East-West, but you can change this.

By clicking the button "Delete Board", you delete the input of a entire board.

By clicking on one of the scores in the list under the input, you can change an already typed in board.
If you click the button of an already typed in pair you can change the typed in score.



As soon as all scores of a group are put in, the button "Calculate result" becomes visible.
You can calculate the ranking or continue the input of the scores of another group.



Knack

With typing the scores is a little trick is build in.

You get a traveller with all same scores.

Let us presume it is a score of -1090 for North-South.

Of course it is boring when you play with 18 pairs and there fore have to put in 9 times -1090.

With Bridge Office Results you have to do it just once.

After the first time you put in -1090 you press the "Enter" key.

The cursor jumps to the next import field.

Press the "Enter" key again and Bridge Office Results fills in the score -1090 for you.

Repeat pressing the "Enter" key as often as necessary.

If there is a sit out pair, this will be passed.

By pressing on the "Enter" key, the last score will fill in each time.

If you want to delete a score in one input field, press the keys <Ctrl> "c" at the same time.

If you used to drop the last 0 (zero) of a score, press "Ctrl" and "S" at the same time.

Bridge Office Results reports "Fast input on".

When you did this, Bridge Office Results remembers this for the future.

If you press "CTRL" and the "S" again, Bridge Office Results reports "Fast input off".

You have to put in the last 0 (zero) of a score your self.

Bridge Office Results remembers this for the next time.

You can do it as often you want to.

Push the enter button again and the board is saved and you can put in the next board number.
Bridge Office Results automatic places the next board number.

After 2 rounds you can calculate an interim score.

You can calculate the ranking or go on with the input of biddings of another group.

Box bridge

With Bridge Office Results it is possible to make a ranking of Box bridge.

For this you must pay attention to:

Pair 1 always plays against pair 2. Pair 3 always plays against pair 4, etc..

Ranking or interim ranking can only be calculated with minimal 6 pairs and maximal 24 pairs.

Schemes are added to calculate a ranking of minimal 6 and maximal 24 pairs.

You can play 10 boxes at the same time and calculate an interim ranking or a ranking.

So you can present an interim ranking from 3 rounds on with percentages.

Always select 4 rounds with the number of rounds for a group (Box)..

Always put in a number of boards that is a multiple of 4.

The number of boards multiplied with the number of rounds is the number of boards played with the box.

The number of Boards to play of a box must always be a multiple of 4.

4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 32 or 36 boards.

Put in the number of pairs of the group (Box) that played the box. (Minimal 6).

Select the scheme for the group (Box) and start with "Thuis bridge".

Click the button start.

Select the group (Box) and start with the input of the scores.

If you put in all the scores, you can calculate a ranking.

If the same box played again, select the date under "Results" where you put in the first scores of the concerning box.

Put back the number of rounds to 4 and raise the number of pairs of the group (Box) with 2 and select the scheme.

You do not need to put in the scores of the pairs that played the box already again.

Only the scores of the pairs which has played the last.



Score table

If you are in "Adjustments (1)", "Adjustments (2)", "Input scores per board" or "Input scores per round" you can call up a score table by pressing the function button F12.

If you want to know the score for down tricks, click the button "Down".

If you want to know the score of a defined bidding, click the little arrow showing to the right, till you see the defined height of the bidding.

Then click the card symbol NT.

All possible scores will be shown.

In the table you see 2 colours.

Blue is NOT VULNERABLE.

Red is VULNERABLE.

If there is an "X" above the table, it is doubled.

If there is "XX" above the table, it is re-doubled.



Send an error message directly to Bridge Office

You have surely seen it once.

The window with in the left top the word "Oops!".

Until now you could save this error message in "Error.txt" and start your e-mail program and send the file as attachment to Bridge Office.

If you filled up the window "Settings" for Internet and E-mail", Bridge Office Results will ask you if the error report must send to Bridge Office".

If you click "Yes", the error report will send immediately.

If Bridge Office Results has sent the report, you receive a message.

Bridge Office will try to give you an answer and/or solution within 24 hours.
