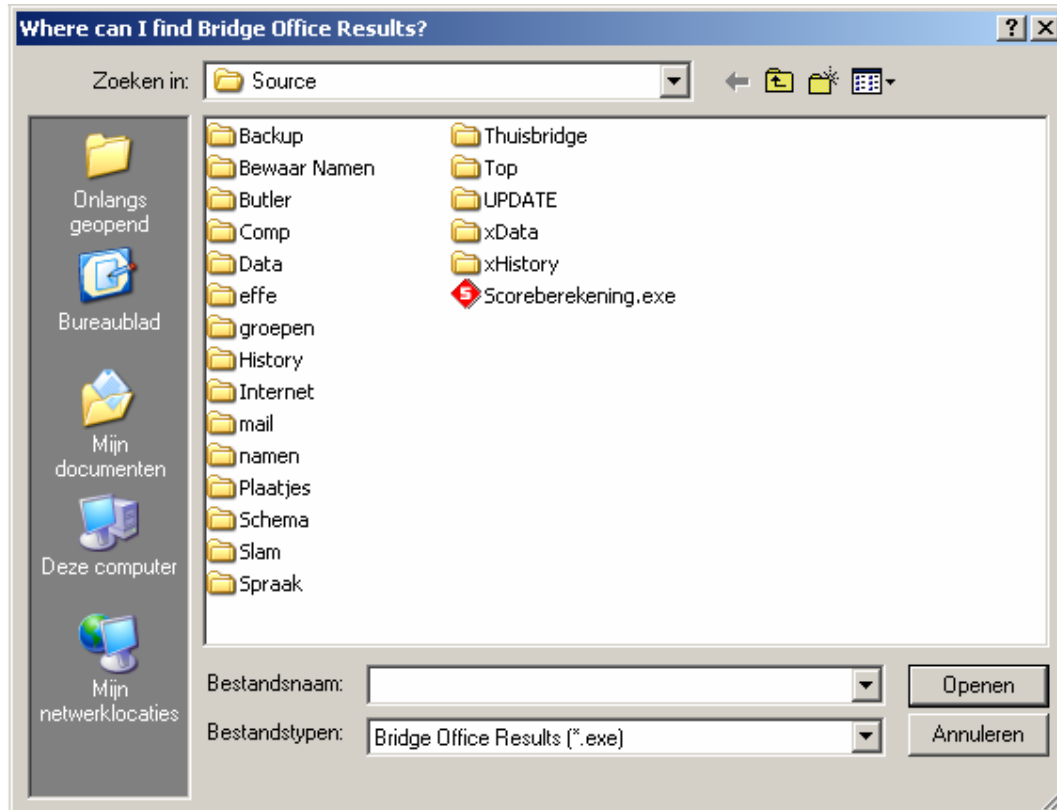

Where is Bridge Office Results

The following window opens.



When "Scoreberekening.exe" does not show, you have to look for the folder where Bridge Office Results is.

Click at Score Calculation.exe and at the button "Open".

You will have to do this only once. Bridge Office Scheme remembers where Bridge Office Results is.

You have returned to the opening screen.

Bridge Office Scheme gives you access to all Bridge Office Results schemes and shows you in the list "Available Schemes" those schemes that apply to the chosen number of "Rounds" and "Pairs".

Without changing anything, you now can start to make a scheme.

Depending on the chosen number of "Rounds" and "Pairs" you can make a new scheme. In this example this is a scheme for 6 Rounds and 12 Pairs.

Making a scheme has one limitation.

You can make a scheme with all tables occupied in each round, or with one table free in each round. Schemes with more free tables in a round are not supported by Bridge Office Scheme.



Click at the button "Make a scheme" and you will see the following screen.

You can raise the numbers of boards until the letter "Z"

This means that you can use sets of boards from A to B until A to Z.

You can raise the number of tables by one.

Enter the name for the scheme without the number of rounds and/or pairs. Bridge Office Scheme will add this when you save the new scheme. In this example we use the name "Sample Scheme".

When you have entered the name of the scheme, you click the button "OK".

You will see the new empty "Sample Scheme".

Back OK Save scheme

The input of the scheme is restricted to certain rules.

Pair numbers lower than 10, must be preceded by a 0 (nought).

The boards to be played must have a letter.

For example, when 4 boards per table and 6 rounds are played, the groups of boards are named as follows: A = 1-4, B = 5-8, C = 9-12, D = 13-16, E = 17-20 and F = 21-24.

The number of boards is not important.

In our example you can see how a group of boards is connected to pairs and/or tables.

Like most modern schemes these always start the same.

An example for round 1: 0102A 0304B 0506C 0708D 0910E 1112F

During input Bridge Office Scheme will check if the input is allowed.

If not, Bridge Office Scheme will report this at once.

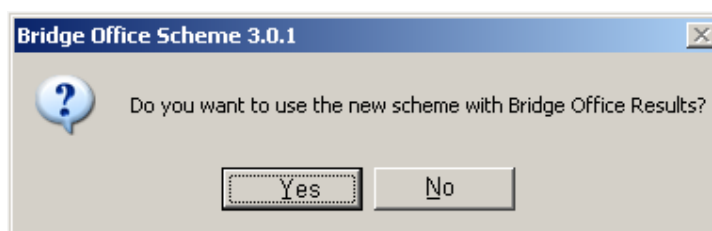

Once you have entered the entire scheme the button "Save Scheme" is active.

Click at this button when you want to save the scheme.

Bridge Office Scheme will now check the scheme. When you have forgotten a pair in a round, or entered a pair twice, Bridge Office Scheme will not save this scheme. Bridge Office Scheme will report in which round a pair number does not show.

When Bridge Office Scheme has approved your new scheme it will ask you the following:



Click at the "Yes" button when you want to use the scheme straight away. Bridge Office Scheme will now place the scheme in the folder "Scheme" of Bridge Office Results.

Click at the "No" button when you do not (yet) want to use the scheme. Bridge Office Scheme will place the scheme in the folder "Other Schemes" below the respective number of rounds.

You can always call this scheme with Bridge Office Scheme for Bridge Office Results.

You return to the opening screen and will find our scheme in the list.

The schemes are listed in alphabetical order.


You will see that Bridge Office Scheme has added the number of pairs and the number of tables to the name of the scheme.
 As our scheme is chosen, all other buttons are active.



Choose a scheme

As Bridge Office Scheme works together with Bridge Office Results schemes can be made or chosen with a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 9 rounds and a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 24 pairs. By clicking one of the arrows behind "Rounds" or "Pairs" you lower or raise the number of rounds and pairs.

At the same time you will see in the list "Available Schemes" those schemes that are available in Bridge Office Results for the combination of "Rounds" and "Pairs" chosen.

Print a scheme

The scheme you called for will be printed.

Bridge Office Scheme asks you to which printer you want to print the scheme.

Bridge Office Scheme will print the scheme in the way you see it on your screen.

You need not worry if it fits the paper.

Bridge Office Scheme will calculate if the scheme fits "Portrait" or "Landscape" and put the printer to "Landscape" when necessary.

Back Save scheme


Changing a scheme goes in the same way as making a new scheme. During changing Bridge Office Scheme will check if a change is allowed. If not, Bridge Office Scheme will report this at once. As soon as you have changed something the button "Save scheme" is active.

Bridge Office Scheme will now check the scheme. When you have forgotten a pair in a round, or entered a pair twice, Bridge Office Scheme will not save this scheme. Bridge Office Scheme will report in which round a pair number does not show.

Bridge Office Scheme will not ask you if you want to use the scheme for Bridge Office Results. Bridge Office Scheme knows where the scheme belongs. You will return to the opening screen and find our scheme in the list.




Print Movement sheets



Bridge Office Scheme wants to know if you want to print a name of a group at the Movement sheets.. There are three possibilities.

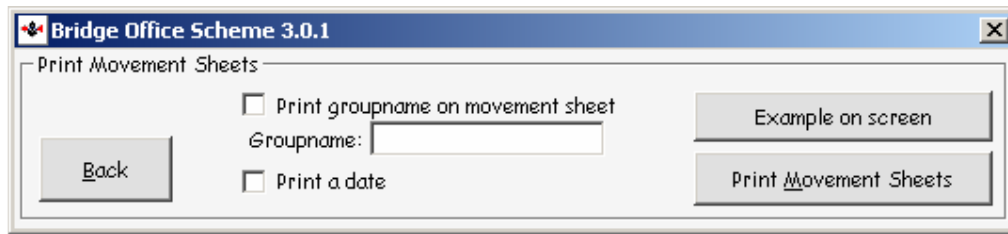
1. Tick "Print Group name at Movement sheet" and NOT enter a Group name.
At every Movement sheet only the word "Group:" is printed.
2. Tick "Print Group name at Movement sheet" and enter a Group name.
At every Movement sheet the word "Group:" and the Group name entered are printed.
3. De-tick "Print Group name at Movement sheet".
The word "Group:" is not printed at the Movement sheets.

You can try the settings by clicking at the button "Sample on screen".
You will see the Movement sheets of Pair 1 and Pair 2.

Click at the button "Back" to return to the previous screen.




When the sample was good, you click at the button "Print Movement sheets".
Bridge Office Scheme asks you to which printer you want to print the Movement sheets to.

The Movement sheets are printed with a maximum of 4 on one page.
When a scheme of 10 pairs is concerned, you will have 2 pages with 4 Movement sheets each and 1 page with 2.

In our "Sample scheme 12p-6r" 3 pages of 4 Movement sheets each are printed.
After printing you return to the opening screen.



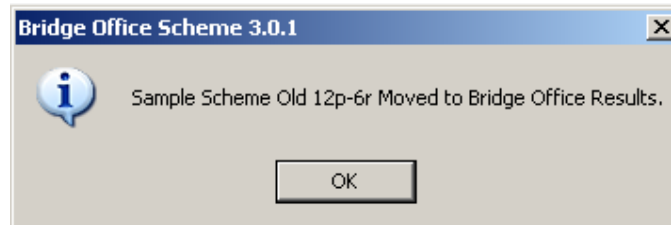

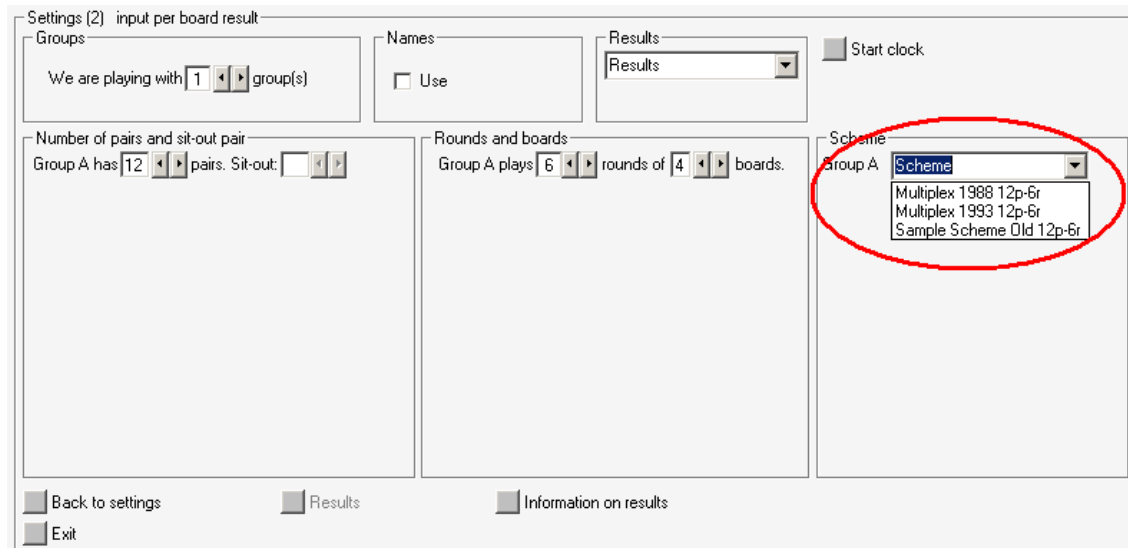


Move a scheme

Delete a scheme

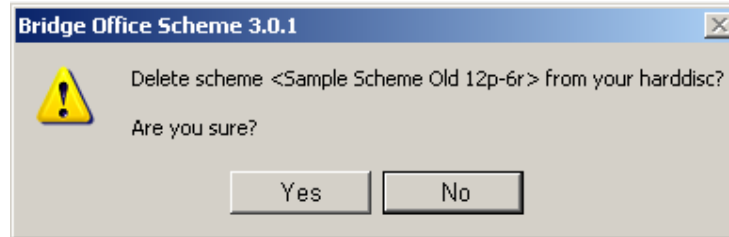
We wish to warn you for this button. We deliberately gave it the color red as this may lead to deleting a scheme permanently.

When it concerns a scheme that is standard in Bridge Office Results (ABS) you can regain the scheme by re-installing the programme.

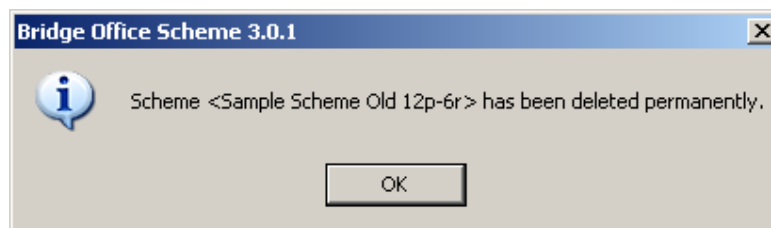
When it concerns a scheme that you have made, it will be lost permanently. You will have to make it all over again.



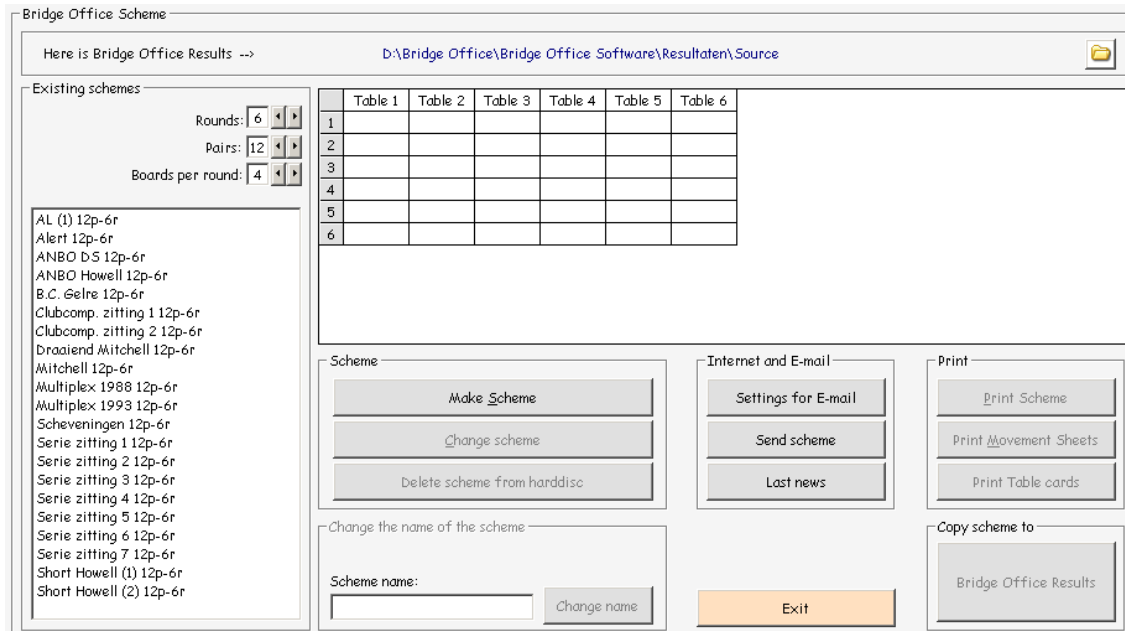
Click in the list at the scheme you wish to delete.
Click at the button "Delete scheme from hard disc".



When you click at the button "Yes", the scheme will be deleted from your hard disc.




The scheme is no longer in the list.

Settings for E-mail



To prevent that somebody use your e-mail program, that maybe is another that is used by your colleague, we choose another way to send the mail.
For this Bridge Office Scheme needs some data.

SMTP server:

The SMTP server of "Yahoo" is "smtp.mail.yahoo.com" and from "Tiscali" it is "smtp.tiscali.co.uk" without quotation marks.

You received a letter from your provider what their SMTP server is.

The username you must type in here is in the letter you received from your provider.

The password you must type in here is in the letter you received from your provider.

Your name:

Here you can change nothing.

With this name you are registered by Bridge Office Scheme.

This name will be used as sender when you are sending schemes.

The receiver can see now where the mail comes from.

Your E-mail address:

There must be a sender known to send the mail.

Put here your own e-mail address in.

Bridge Office Results sends the e-mail to this address and all others via BCC, so no one else can see the other addresses.

Because you also send the mail to your self, you can check what you have sent.

Check with starting up if there is a new version:

When you click on this field, every 2 hours and with starting up Bridge Office Scheme,



you can see if there is a new version on Internet.
You will receive a message from Bridge Office Scheme.

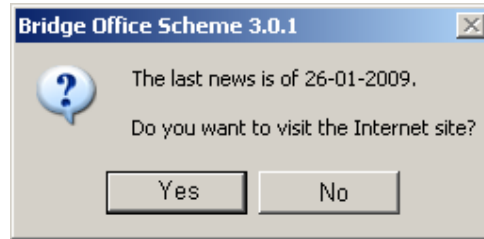
